

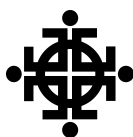

Bishop Cecil O. Reid American Academy of Lima

Summary

I proposed that the **online academy agreement** between the International Academic Education Consortium (IAEC) and Alpha Omega Publications (AOP) be amendment to include the international mission of IAEC in South America beginning in the country of Peru. Furthermore, the mission is to introduce Pre K – 12 curricula based on Alpha Omega Publications Switched-On Online™ initially in the Santa Rosa District of Lima Peru. The Academy has as its prime objective - to demonstrate the benefits of AOP curricula to the hundreds of private collegio institutions for potential dual enrollment with Alpha Omega Academy®. The local academy's name is **Bishop Cecil O. Reid American Academy of Lima**, hereafter referred to as (Academy). The Academy will serve as an “*education model*” for IAEC educational interest in South America. The initial cost of the project is as follows: A. local area network equipment, \$8,660.00 B. first year personnel, \$11,400.00. IAEC will bear the initial approximately cost \$20,060.00.

Furthermore, the proposed facilities for the Academy will be located on the campus of Smith Chapel Bible University Complex, an academic institution legally approved, by the ministry of education, to operate in the country. The complex currently under construction will accommodate multiple classrooms and provide academy administrative support with an expected completion date late August or early December 2009 based on projected funding levels. Thus, it's proposed that AOP support IAEC curricula pricing based on an economy of scale of currency in Peru, the Nuevo Sol. AOP pricing to IAEC is essential for establishing a self-supporting “*education model*” in South America funded by tuition and fees.

Moreover, the project scope is to create an American Style School System with a minimum of 1000 School Academic Centers either by acquiring existing schools or purchasing land for development. The private school system, once developed, will be self-supporting by tuition, fees and donations. The five-year plan to serve a minimum of one-million under privilege children (Pre K – 12) is based on an average monthly tuition rate of \$25.00 = S/81.25 considering a sliding economic scale.

Finally, annual revenue projections equals three hundred million dollars (\$300,000,000.00) from tuition and fees, one-million dollars from IAEC pending partnership with Hughes Network System (1,000,000.00), five hundred thousand dollars net from the project's FalconJet acquisition Charter Revenue (\$500,000.00), fifty-thousand from hacienda acquisition (hotel) (\$50,000.00) and one-hundred & fifty thousand from miscellaneous bookstore sales (\$150,000.00). The total projected five-year revenue equals $\$301,700,000.00 \times 5 = \$1,508,500,000.00$ and the requested proposal funding approximately \$1,000,000,000.00 to primarily fund six areas of need: (1) Acquisition of existing schools, (2) Acquisition of land and its development (3) Acquisition of a thirty room hacienda (4) Acquisition and installation a countrywide satellite network system (5) Acquisition a business class jet and (6) Acquisition and development of human resources with the employment of approximately fifty-thousand employees plus benefits (50,000).

Mission Statement

School History

About Alpha Omega Academy

Alpha Omega Publications (AOP) established Alpha Omega Academy in 1992 as an additional service to those families who wanted their children to learn at home, but enjoyed the teaching and support of an educational institution. Initially, a mail correspondence program servicing grades K-8 and using the LIFEPAC work text curriculum was created. Grades 9-12 were added later.

In 1997, AOP introduced the Switched-On Schoolhouse (SOS) multimedia curriculum. The following year, it created Alpha Omega Academy Online to allow students the support of an academy with the educational power of SOS. The SOS computer-based program grew quickly, servicing grades 3-12.

The two Academy programs developed separately and operated independently of each other for several years. Eventually the two Academy programs integrated into one distance education school, enrolling students with their choice of either LIFEPAC or SOS curriculum, or even a combination of both.

In 2008, Bishop Cecil O. Reid American Academy of Lima through its Partnership in Christian Education with Alpha Omega Academy was authorized by the International Academic Education Consortium, in conjunction with the Central Truth Ministries, Inc., USA, the Church of God Apostolic, Inc., USA, Smith Chapel Bible University, Holy Spirit World Church and the Five-Fold Ministries, Lima Peru. It is a Bible based non-profit, private day school supported by tuition and fees. The program is co-educational, non-residential and extends from (Pre K – 12). A 12-member Board of Directors governs the Academy.

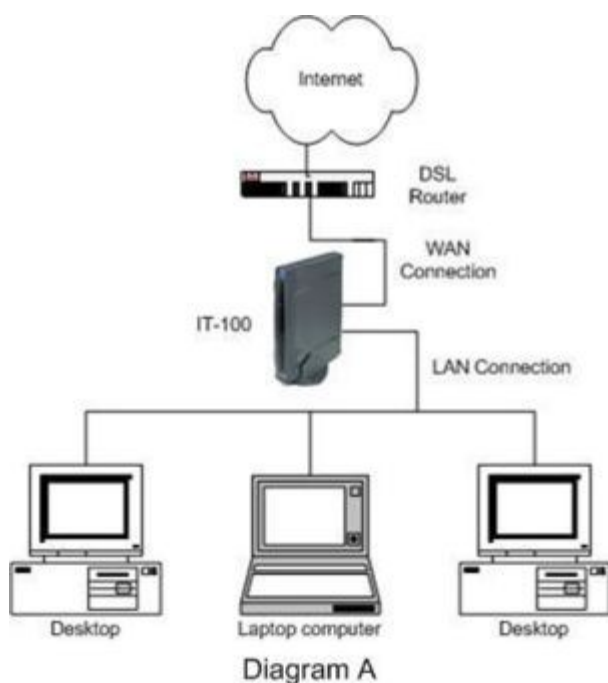

Economy - overview:  

Peru's economy reflects its varied geography - an arid coastal region, the Andes further inland, and tropical lands bordering Colombia and Brazil. Abundant mineral resources are found in the mountainous areas, and Peru's coastal waters provide excellent fishing grounds. However, overdependence on minerals and metals subjects the economy to fluctuations in world prices, and a lack of infrastructure deters trade and investment. After several years of inconsistent economic performance, the Peruvian economy grew by more than 4% per year during the period 2002-06, with a stable exchange rate and low inflation. Growth jumped to 7.5% in 2007, driven by higher world prices for minerals and metals. Risk premiums on Peruvian bonds on secondary markets reached historically low levels in late 2004, reflecting investor optimism regarding the government's prudent fiscal policies and openness to trade and investment. Despite the strong macroeconomic performance, underemployment and poverty have stayed persistently high. Growth prospects depend on exports of minerals, textiles, and agricultural products, and by expectations for the Camisea natural gas mega project and for other promising energy projects. Upon taking office, President GARCIA announced Sierra Exportadora, a program aimed at promoting economic growth in Peru's southern and central highlands.

The American School of Lima (Colegio Franklin D. Roosevelt) is a private, coeducational day school that was founded in 1946. It offers an educational program from EC3 through grade 12 for students of all nationalities. The school year comprises 2 semesters extending from August 1 to December 21 and from February 28 to June 27.

Organization: The School is governed by a 12-member Board of Directors representing the Instituto Educacional Franklin Delano Roosevelt. Under this operating entity, the School is tax-exempt in Peru. The School is supported in the United States by "The American School of Lima Foundation" and is tax-exempt in the United States.

Curriculum: The curriculum follows the criteria of the International Baccalaureate that includes the primary years program (PYP), the Middle Years Program (MYP) and the Diploma Program (DP). Last year Roosevelt became authorized as an MYP and PYP School; while the DP has been in place since 1993. All graduates are awarded an American High School Diploma and also have the option of attaining an International Baccalaureate and/or an Official Peruvian Program Diploma. The teaching strategies are similar to an American school, whereas the curriculum is truly a blend of the IB and American academic programs. The academic rigor and external accountability of the DP has made it a highly regarded and popular college preparation program in many high schools across the United States. Universities recognize the Roosevelt curriculum for being dynamic and challenging, which is evident by students' acceptances at top universities. The School is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and offers a limited range of programs for students with special needs, including mild learning disabilities, English-as-a-Second-Language and speech and language therapy. Spanish language instruction begins in Grade 1 and French is offered for three years in the high school.

Faculty: In the 2007-2008 school year, there are 129 full-time and 3 part-time faculty members.

Enrollment: At the beginning of the 2007-2008 school year, enrollment was 1,329 (PK-grade 5: 701; grades 6-8: 268; and grades 9-12: 360).

Facilities: The preschool, elementary, middle and high school programs are housed in 8 separate buildings on a well-landscaped, 21-acre campus in residential Lima. The School has 7 modern science laboratories, 4 music rooms, 2 multipurpose areas, a complete media center, 2 gymnasiums, and numerous sports fields. In addition to computers for teachers, there are 115 computers for student use in elementary school, 104 in the middle school, 140 in the high school, and 55 in the Media Center. A swimming pool will be completed in October of 2007 and plans for a new Performing Arts Center are underway.

Finances: In the 2007-2008 school year, about 95% of the School's income derives from tuition and donations. Annual tuition rates are as follows: EC-Kdg.: \$7,800; grades 1-5: \$8,450, and grades 6-12: \$8,850. Busing is available for an extra fee. There is a \$6,800 entrance fee for all students and a \$200 application fee. In addition, there is a technology fee of \$200 per year. (All fees are quoted in U.S. dollars.)
